

Call for Papers for the Digital Spring Meeting of the Section on Migration and Ethnic Minorities of the German Sociological Association, April 25-26, 2024

Current research on migration and ethnic minorities

The spring meeting of the Section Migration and Ethnic Minorities of the German Sociological Association (DGS) will take place on **April 25-26, 2024**. The online conference provides a forum for the presentation of current projects in the field of the section. This includes the presentation of empirically oriented research (qualitative and quantitative) as well as the discussion of theoretical and methodological approaches. Furthermore, we welcome presentations that address the intersection of theory and empirical research in order to initiate an exchange between different approaches to the field. This is intended to foster dialogue, while at the same time providing a forum for the publication of new research projects.

We invite researchers from all academic levels to present and discuss their current work. Submissions from young scholars are especially welcome.

The conference will be held online on April 25-26, 2024. Presentations will be approximately 20 minutes in length and will be presented in themed panels. The exact topics of the panels will be announced after the submission of abstracts. We welcome abstracts (German or English) of **no more than 300 words** that, in addition to the usual information, provide information on the research context or the status of the underlying project.
